IMMUNISATIONS AT CULCHETH HIGH SCHOOL

The Community Nurse arranges for a team of nurses to come in to Culcheth High School and administer the up to date immunisations required for your child.

Autumn Term

Y8 girls HPV Immunisation (protects against the two types that cause most cases (over 70%) of cervical cancer. This is the first of two doses given six months apart. An assembly will be delivered giving the information to students and the consent forms sent home and asked to be returned to school.

Without written consent your child cannot be given the immunisation.

Spring Term

Y9 boys & girls Tetanus; Diphtheria; Polio and Meningitis. All students in Y9 are given two injections (one in each arm in one sitting). The information and consent forms are usually given out in form.

Without written consent your child cannot be given the immunisation.

Summer Term

Y8 girls HPV Immunisation – the second dose.

Without written consent your child cannot be given the immunisation.

The nurses come in one day after the immunisations to provide a “mop up” service for any students who were absent on the day but if students miss this, or no written consent is received, then parents have the option to take their child to their local Doctor.
