Year 11 Study/Revision Arrangements

After May half term, there are still a large number of exams. As a result, a number of subjects will be offering crammer sessions, and lessons will continue as normal up to the official school leaving day which is Friday 23 June 2017. If after the half term students prefer to study at home, this is acceptable, but we strongly recommend students attend crammers and lessons until either the exam has been completed for that subject or until Monday 26 June 2017.

Students attending crammer sessions/normal lessons from after half term will only be able to leave or enter site at the following times:

- Start of day as normal (8.30-8.40am)
- End of lunch (12.50pm)
- End of day as normal (3.00pm)
- Leave after the exam

Any students leaving site at the times above must sign out with a member of staff via the side gate, which will be opened at these times. All help and support, including exam timetables and protocols are available through i-Revise which is on the website in the parent portal.

On Friday 23 June, all Year 11 students will be in school in their own clothes, suitable for the final Year 11 Celebration Day. Students will have normal lessons P1 and P2 and will be in their final celebration assembly P3. We expect students to leave the school site at approximately 12.45pm.

A small number of students have a one-hour exam on Friday 23rd June. These students must arrive for their exam in school uniform, however changing facilities will be available for the students straight after the exam, or they may go home to change. If your child does go home to change, they must return and sign in by break time, where they will then join in celebrations. No leavers celebrations will be missed by students in the exam, as all other students will be in lessons.
