Y11 EXAMINATION INFORMATION

Monday 15th May – Monday 26th June



DATES & TIMES

- The school will change to a 3:2 split from Monday 15th May to 23rd June
- Arrive in King Quad for 8.40am for a prompt 9.00am start for morning exams
- **Line up in King Quad at 1.00pm for afternoon exams**
- Line up in tutor group order facing the main school hall (**Go to the toilet first**)
- Listen to instructions from your Progress Leader or SLT and wait to be instructed into the hall
- Do not go to registration (unless you do not have an exam or the day of the listening exams).



VENUES

- The school hall
- S115/C204/B207 (alternative venues may be used)
- Check the exams notice board next to student services for your room and seat number – please ensure you sit in the correct seat (you should have already received an exam timetable with your rooms and seat numbers)
- If you have extra time you will be seated at the far side of the hall for minimum disturbance - for afternoon exams you may have to find an alternative route home if you catch the school bus



SILENCE/ EXAM CONDITIONS

- Once you enter the exam hall you are under exam conditions
- Do not communicate with any other candidate
- Sit quietly and face the front at all times
- If you need assistance please put your hand up and wait for an invigilator – please remember invigilators cannot help you with any of your answers on your question paper



GENERAL INFORMATION

- Bring black pens, pencil, pencil sharpener, ruler, rubber in a see-through pencil case (for some exams you may need other equipment)
- **Make sure you use black ink only as any other colour will not show up if the exam paper is scanned**
- A calculator – where one is allowed (remove calculator case and clear anything stored in the memory)
- You must **NOT** use correcting fluid and erasable pens
- You must **NOT** use highlighters or gel pens in your answers (Questions, text extracts, individual words or phrases may be highlighted)
- **Memorise your 4-digit candidate number**
- **You must put your legal name on your question paper (not your preferred name/no nick names)**



GENERAL INFORMATION

- Please do not bring any rough notes to the exam
- No food/drink other than water in an unlabelled clear bottle
- Mobile phones or any other electronic equipment including SMART watches/i-Watches and Calculator watches are **NOT** allowed in the exam room
- If you bring any electronic equipment (including smart watches or i-watches) it must be handed in to the invigilator – ticket system
- Coats, bags etc. are to be left in lockers
- Ensure you wear the correct uniform
- Do not write inappropriate, obscene or offensive material in your exam script as it will not be marked



GENERAL INFORMATION

- Check that you have the correct question paper and the correct tier/level – please inform an invigilator if you do not have the correct paper
- Read through all the instructions before you start writing
- **Please write within the specified margins as some exam papers are scanned and will only pick up your answers within the margins**
- Any rough work should be done in your answer booklet and should be neatly crossed out
- At the end of the exam please ensure you have put your details on all your answer booklets and ensure your answers are correctly numbered
- When you are being dismissed from the hall you must remain silent as other students may still be working
- In the event of a fire evacuation listen to instructions given by the invigilator



GENERAL INFORMATION

- The School Hall will be out of action at lunchtimes and break times from Monday 15th May to Friday 30th June
- Packed lunches moved to Shakespeare – year group allocated rooms
- **Afternoon exams – you have to remain supervised until 1.30pm therefore for 1 hour exams you will have to remain in the exam venue in complete silence when you have finished**
- Do not be late – if you are late please report to Student Services
