4. To monitor and evaluate progress against the School Improvement Plan. This includes looking strategically at headline exam results, with detailed analysis undertaken by Curriculum and Standards committee.
  - To support and challenge the SEF and to receive external reports related to the school's performance.
  - To support and monitor pre and post Ofsted inspection activities and ensure recommendations are followed up.
5. To delegate the powers to relevant Committees to make decisions on behalf of the Governing Body within their remit.
