Dear Parents and Carers

I am writing to inform you that the Governing Body of Culcheth High School has taken the decision to consult on a proposal to change the shape of the school day. The Headteacher and Governing Body of Culcheth High School are proposing to change the shape of one school day every fortnight in order to facilitate additional training and development with effect from September 2018.

The start times for both staff and students will, largely, remain unchanged every day of the week. Students will also leave school at the same time on nine out of the ten days each fortnight. The change will affect Monday Week Two only, where students will leave school at 2.00pm. The school buses will depart school early on Mondays to ensure that children can get home. In addition, should any students in Years 7 or 8 need to stay in school to await transportation, then they will be accommodated up to the usual finish time of 3.00pm.

Full details of the proposal can be found on the school website and paper copies of the proposal can be supplied upon request. Alternatively please ask your son or daughter to collect a copy from Student Services in school, or you can pick up a copy from the school at your convenience.

The consultation runs from Monday 21st May to Monday 4th June 2018. Responses can be completed using the pro-forma in the consultation booklet or online by using the link provided in the consultation booklet. The reasons for the proposal can be found in the consultation booklet and on the school website.

Please take time to read the information on the website and/or in the consultation booklet and I look forward to hearing your views.
