### **Year 6 Transition – September Arrangements**

I am writing to you to provide a further update of our adapted Year 6 transition process including some key information regarding our current plans for September.

Our last letter confirmed the Form Group arrangements and I would like to remind you that all future Year 7s have been invited to join a specific Form Group Google Classroom as we hope that this will provide another way for our new students to interact with their new Form Tutor and other members of their form.

The following information explains some of the practical arrangements for the start of term on Monday 7<sup>th</sup> September. I hope that this will cover the main questions that you might have and additional information will be made available on the school website in the last week of August.

- All students will start the new school year on Monday 7<sup>th</sup> September.
- Each year group will be placed into a separate Learning Zone with their own classrooms and break and lunch time areas.
- Students will be able to travel to school using school buses and the details regarding timetables and routes will be provided on the school website as soon as possible.
- All students should arrive at school by 8.35am on Monday 7<sup>th</sup> September. We ask that parents remain in their cars if dropping off in the school car park and staff will be in place at the front and rear of school to direct students to their year group Learning Zone.
- Students should wear full school uniform. If there have been issues with the purchase of school uniform over the summer then please write a note that can be shown to Form Tutors on the first day.
- Students do not need to bring a PE kit to school on Monday 7<sup>th</sup> September.
- You will shortly receive a letter providing login details for the school's ParentPay service. This can be used to add money to your son/daughter's catering account and food may be purchased at break time and lunch time from Monday 7<sup>th</sup> September. There will also be a designated area in each Learning Zone for students to eat packed lunches.
- Unfortunately, we will not initially be able to issue locker keys. This is because the lockers are situated across the school site and accessing lockers would require students to move between Learning Zones. We hope to be able to issue locker keys to Year 7 students once the restrictions are lifted.

More information is provided on the school website and this will be updated during the summer to reflect the current situation and latest government guidelines.

May I once again take this opportunity to thank you for your patience, continued support and wish you, your family and loved ones a restful summer. #WeAreCHS.
