### **Wednesday 13<sup>th</sup> January 2021**

- Students who show signs of COVID-19 symptoms must stay at home, arrange a test and inform the school immediately of the results, isolation details and any potential 'close contacts'
- Culcheth High School will follow guidance from Public Health England and the Local Authority to implement a school based 'Track & Trace' system to identify potential 'close contacts' of any confirmed positive case
- Students identified as a 'close contact' will be informed by telephone and confirmation of isolation arrangements sent via an email/letter
- Students not identified as 'close contacts' should attend school as per normal ensuring all hygiene and social distancing measures are followed at all times

  - the date of onset of symptoms
  - the date of test
  - the date of positive result
  - any 'close contacts' at break, lunch and on school bus 48 hours prior to the onset of symptoms
- Receiving this information in a timely manner is invaluable to the school's ability to track and trace effectively.
