### **End of Term Arrangements and Start of Year 2021-2022 Arrangements**

I am writing to inform you of the arrangements for the end of term and the provisional plan for the start of the academic year 2021-2022, in light of recent developments.

### **Monday 19<sup>th</sup> July to Thursday 22<sup>nd</sup> July Arrangements**

In line with the latest DfE School Guidance regarding the easing of restrictions from Monday 19<sup>th</sup> July, we will be continuing with all of our current school operational arrangements for the last four days of the term. At the time of writing this letter, Warrington is still a COVID Enhanced Support Area, there are a rising number of cases in the school and local community, therefore students and staff will continue to wear face masks in all communal areas of school until the end of term.

If this changes, before Monday, we will communicate further details to you.

On the last day, Thursday 22<sup>nd</sup> July 2021, we will be holding a virtual full-school assembly to give out relevant awards and bring the year to an end by celebrating success.

### **September 2021**

Further to the latest school COVID operational guidance, when schools return in September all students will participate in an on-site asymptomatic testing programme similar to when students returned to school in March. All secondary students will need to be tested twice in a three-to-five day period when they return.

The Department for Education have granted schools permission to stagger the start of the school year to support this. We will also be asking students to test themselves with an LFT prior to returning to school on their allocated date. Tests will be provided by school before the end of the current academic year.

The provisional arrangements for the start of the 2021/2022 academic year are:

**Monday 6<sup>th</sup> September** – **Year 7 & Year 8** students return to school for testing and full induction day activities. Year 7 & Year 8 students remain in school all week.

**Tuesday 7<sup>th</sup> September** – **Year 10 & Year 11** students return to school for testing and induction. Year 10 & Year 11 students remain in school for the remainder of the week.

**Wednesday 8<sup>th</sup> September** – **Year 9** students return to school for testing and induction. Year 9 students remain in school for the remainder of the week.

These arrangements will be confirmed prior to the start of the academic year and the testing schedule for all students will be publicised prior to students returning to school.
